

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, land rates and rates of exchange in effect Feb. 24, 2010. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. Refunds can NOT be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. If fewer than 20 pilgrims participate a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required, passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months after return date. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Citizens of countries other than U.S. - please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure.

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$562 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. Current International departure taxes of \$80 plus current fuel surcharges of \$280 are included. (Subject to change) Tips to Tour Manager/Guides, drivers and dining rooms staff of \$75 are included. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (height plus width plus depth is permitted throughout the trip.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$300 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of

departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Amex, Visa and MasterCard are accepted with signed reservation form. Final payments will be applied to same credit card on final payment due date. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure — \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 8 days of departure — \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. No refund for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$200 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc. Additional deposits may be necessary 90 days prior to departure. Final payments will be required 60 days prior to departure. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

CHANGE FEE: All changes not received in writing at least 30 days prior to departure will incur a \$35 change fee per person for each revision.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen emergencies.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Unitours, Inc., the organizer, and their representatives act only as agents for the tour members in making arrangements for hotels, transportation, sightseeing, restaurants or any other services in connection with the itinerary. They will exercise reasonable care in making such arrangements, however, they do not assume any liability whatsoever, for any injury, damage, loss, accident or delay to person or property because of any acts of war or terrorism, any act of default of any hotel, carrier, restaurant, company or person rendering any of the services included in the tours. The tickets, coupons, tariffs, rules or contracts currently in use by any carrier, hotel, restaurant or other contractor rendering services shall constitute the sole contract between such contractor and the tour member. **Unitours Inc., or the organizer, accept no responsibility for any damage or delay due to sickness, pilferage, labor disputes, machinery breakdown, quarantine, government restraints, weather or any other cause beyond their personal control.** No carrier shall be responsible for any act, omission or events during the time passengers are not on board its own conveyance. The right is reserved to cancel or change itineraries, or substitute services without notice and to decline to accept or retain any passenger at any time. In view of statutory or contractual limitations that may apply to personal injury or property damage losses the purchase of accident and baggage insurance is strongly recommended. 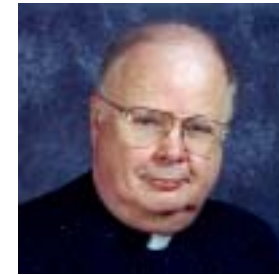

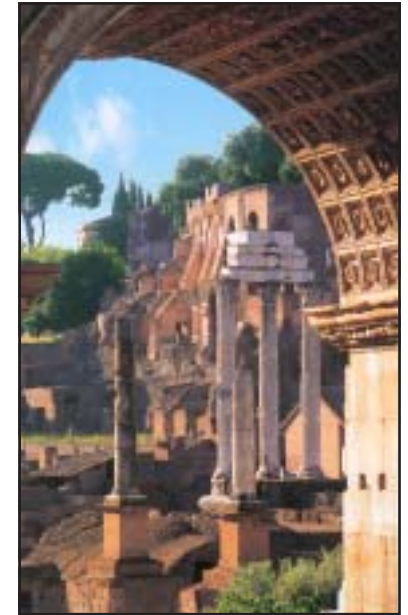

DAILY ITINERARY

Wednesday, October 27 - Day 1 – DEPART - This evening, we depart JFK via best connections for our overnight flight to Rome aboard a wide-bodied jet. We enjoy in-flight movies, dinner and breakfast aloft.

Thursday, October 28 - *Simon & Jude* - Day 2 - ROME/SORRENTO - This morning we arrive in Rome and depart for Sorrento. We celebrate Mass on the way to Sorrento. Finally, we enter the beautiful seaside resort of Sorrento for dinner and overnight.

Friday, October 29 - Day 3 - SORRENTO//POMPEII/SORRENTO - This morning, after Mass in a local church, we make our excursion to Pompeii, the Roman City destroyed but yet preserved by the volcanic ash of Vesuvius in 79 AD. This afternoon is free to wander the beautiful town of Sorrento. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Saturday, October 30 - Day 4 - SORRENTO/CAPRI/BLUE GROTTO/SORRENTO - This morning, after Mass in a local church, we leave Sorrento by steamer across the Bay of Naples to the Island of Dreams - Capri. We tour the island, including Anacapri and, weather permitting, the beautiful Blue Grotto. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Sunday, October 31 - Day 5– SORRENTO/AMALFI DRIVE - This morning, we celebrate Mass in a local church, or attend a regularly scheduled Sunday Mass. We then travel the famous Amalfi Drive. The narrow and twisting Amalfi Drive in Italy is arguably the world's most beautiful and thrilling sightseeing road. It stretches 50 kilometers (30 miles) between Sorrento city and Amalfi village (which gave the coast its name). We stop in Amalfi Village for lunch and free time, before returning to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Monday, November 1 - *All Saints* - DAY 6 - SORRENTO/SAN GIOVANNI - This morning we depart for Padre Pio's San Giovanni Rotondo. We celebrate Mass at Padre Pio's tomb and then visit his cell; the old church where he received the stigmata; his confessional and the Church of Santa Maria Delle Grazia. We have the opportunity to visit the new Basilica and grounds which were recently completed. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Tuesday, November 2 - *All Souls* - DAY 7 - ROME - SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ROME - This morning we drive to the Cave of St. Michael, where we celebrate Mass. We continue to Rome. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Wednesday, November 3 - Day 8 - ROME - This morning, we make our way to St. Peter's for the Audience with Pope Benedict XVI, if he is in residence. This afternoon we visit St. Paul Outside the Walls; second in size only to St. Peter's - it is the tomb of the Apostle Paul. We make our way to St. Mary Major. This is the first church dedicated to the Blessed Mother first built in the fifth century following the Council of Ephesus. We end the day at one of the Catacombs. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Thursday, November 4 - Day 9 – ROME - This morning, we begin our day at St. Peter's, where we celebrate Mass. Afterwards, we see the treasures of the Vatican Museum. We marvel at Michelangelo's recently restored frescoes in the Sistine Chapel and the wonders of St. Peter's. This afternoon, we tour the sites, including a guided tour of the Coliseum. Balance of day free. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Friday, November 5 - Day 10 – ROME – FREE DAY. Dinner on our own.
